STADIUM CODE OF CONDUCT

- Be security searched at the entry points as per local law. Refusal will end in denied access into the stadium facilities. The search regime is for everyone entering the stadium, including all staff, goods deliverers, volunteers and members of the public
- Conduct themselves in a manner that is not offensive to, endangers the safety of, hinders or harasses others.
- Only occupy seats and hospitality facilities as indicated on the ticket and/or accreditation
- Not cause obstructions or restrict the circulation of people or vehicles
- Not drop litter
- Not Smoke in any of the Stadium facilities.
- Not enter the field of play or other restricted areas.
- Not obstruct the view of others
- Not throw any objects or substances at others or on to the field of play
- Not cause fire or the risk of fire or use pyrotechnics of any kind
- Not act in a manner that could cause offence to others, including but not restricted to acts of racism
- Not act in a manner that could detract from the sporting event.
- Not sell goods or tickets to others unless authorized to do so.
- Not create any threat to safety or life, or harm themselves or others.
- Not be intoxicated or show any other signs of impairment that results in irresponsible behavior
- Not climb on or over any structures not intended for general use.
- Unless authorized to do so, not record, photograph, transmit or disseminate any sound, image, description or result of any activity within the stadium for commercial use.
- Not act in a manner that could distract or harm the players or officials.
- Not engage in any activity that could compromise the safety, security or reputation of the event.
- Not breach any local United Arab Emirates Law
- Allow the organizer the right to deny access to the stadium facilities if any of the above Code of Conducts have been breached by any staff member and ticket holder
- Agree, by entering the stadium facility, to be filmed, photographed and / or recorded, and allows the organizer to reuse these images without consent of the person displayed in any of the content
- Not obstruct or block the stadium bowl stairways or vomitorias. They are to be kept clear to give access to medical services if required
- Vacate the Stadium as directed by the Security Personnel
- Not use Foul or abusive language
- Not present damaged, defaced or tickets purchased from an unauthorized seller. They will not permit the holder to enter the stadium
- Not claim any refund after being ejected from the stadium for any reason whatsoever
- Enter the stadium at their own risk. The Stadium will not be held responsible for any damages to, loss or theft of personal property.

PROHIBITED ITEMS LIST AT STADIUMS

- Weapons, sharp objects of any kind
- Anything that could be used as a weapon or to cut, thrust or stab, or as a projectile, in particular long umbrellas and other unwieldy implements
- Bottles, cups, jugs or cans of any kind as well as other objects made from PET, glass or any other fragile, non-shatterproof or especially tough material or Tetra Pak packaging, hard cooler boxes
- Fireworks, flares, smoke powder, smoke canisters, smoke bombs or other pyrotechnics, matches, lighters and cigarettes
- Alcoholic beverages of any kind, narcotics or stimulants
- Racist, xenophobic cause, charity or ideological concern related materials, including but not limited to banners, signs, symbols and leaflets, objects or clothing, which could impair the enjoyment of the Event by other spectators, or detract from the sporting focus of the Event
- Flagpoles of soft material, no longer than 300mm, with a maximum of 10mm diameter
- Large banners and flags. Smaller flags of the attending countries (Max 150cm x 200cm) and banners are permitted, provided that they are made from material which is deemed "of low flammability" and complies with national regulations and standards and do not contain offensive or political motivated slogans and/or text.
- Any sort of animals
- Any promotional or commercial, materials, including but not limited to banners, signs, symbols and leaflets, or any kind of promotional or commercial objects, material and clothing
- Any aerosols, perfume bottles, gas spray cans, corrosive, flammable substances, dyes or receptacles containing substances which are harmful to health or are highly flammable. Standard pocket cigarette lighters are not permitted
- Unwieldy objects such as ladders, stools, (folding) chairs, boxes, paperboard containers, large bags, rucksacks, suitcases and sports bags. "Unwieldy" is given to mean all objects which are larger than 25cmx25cmx25cm and which cannot be stowed under the seat in the Stadium
- Large quantities of paper and/or rolls of paper or any kind of inflatable balloons or any balls.
- Mechanically and manually operated instruments which produce an excessive volume of noise such as, but not limited to, megaphones, vuvuzelas, hooters or gas-powered horns, drums bigger than 60cm x 40cm, bugles of any other material than plastic and larger than 25cm
- Laser pointers
- Cameras with detachable lens (even for private use, non-detachable lens only with one set of replacement or rechargeable batteries), video cameras or other sound or video recording equipment
- Computers or other devices used for the purposes of transmitting or disseminating sound, pictures, descriptions or results of the events via the internet or other forms of media
- Food and drinks (unless required for medical reasons or for babies younger than 2 years old)
- **NO SMOKING; no cigarettes, cigars, electronic smoking devices, lighters, matches or any other smoking and lighting equipment**
- Other objects which could compromise public safety and/or harm the reputation of the Event as assessed at the sole discretion of the Local Authorities and LOC
